



Job Title: Camp Agape Intern

Position Overview

Come live in an urban neighborhood with other ministry-minded young adults. Spend the day ministering to neighborhood children in a summer day camp program, and the evenings having fellowship with your fellow ministers. The internship will provide housing at no cost, a salary of \$2000, and meal stipend. Dates of the camp run from June 11th to July 26th. Training starts on move-in day which is June 4th, and the final cleanout happens on July 27th. You must be willing to go "all-in" for the summer. There will be little to no time for outside activities during the summer term.

Essential Job Functions

Discipleship Community: You don't punch out at 5p.m. Part of this experience is learning with your teammates what Christian Community is all about. This will be hard for some and easy for others.

- Explicit Spiritual Activities
 - Weekly devotional book study of *Theirs is The Kingdom* by Bob Lupton.
 - Weekly interactive ministry training with Agape senior staff.
 - It is vital for your own spiritual health that you plug into some church for the summer. You are invited (not required) to participate in Restoration Community Church on Sundays.
- Roommate Community
 - 2 dinners per week must be shared-communal meal (1 with your house, 1 with all interns)
 - Share responsibilities for keeping the house clean.
 - Fellowship activities together to get to know one another.
 - Caring for each other and looking out for the greater good.

Summer Camp Program: From 1pm to 6pm, M-Th you will be working on Summer Camp activities. This will be a time dedicated to the kids, and you will have defined role within the camp.

- Being a spiritual and recreational leader.
- Participating in and leading camp skits.
- Effectively managing child behavior.
- Relating to children in difficult circumstances from inner city families.
- Supervising Thursday field trips.
- Reporting to Camp Director

Neighborhood Outreach

- **Fellowship Events:** 1 night per week lead a Young adult fellowship activity
 - Target your peers in the neighborhood.

- You will have a budget and funds to spend on activities.
- Plan the activities 1 week in advance.
- Get approval from senior staff
- Coordinate any reservations, transportation, etc.
- Market the event to residents of the neighborhood.

Requirements

Must have valid driver's license. A vehicle and adequate driving record are a bonus.
Must be a people person. You will be around people most of the day for 6 days per week.
Must have an active relationship with Jesus Christ.
You must be **high energy**. The kids will run you ragged if you do not.
Must love working with children.

Not required but strongly encouraged:

Cross cultural relationship skills.
Passion for at-risk youth or inner city communities.

COMPENSATION

The compensation for the summer is \$2,000 (pre-tax). Agape Development will provide an all bills paid housing environment as well as a weekly meal stipend.
