### **Position Overview**

Come work in an urban neighborhood with at-risk children. Spend the afternoon teaching and ministering to neighborhood children in an after-school program that serves kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> graders. Required times are Mondays from 1:30-6pm and Tuesdays-Thursdays from 2:30-6pm. The rate of pay is \$10/hour. The position starts August 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **Essential Job Functions**

**After-School Program:** From 3:30-5:30, you will be running, teaching, and managing your grade-level classroom.

- Assisting in safe transportation from schools to Agape
- Participating in outdoor active play and recreational games with the students
- Leading effective homework time and tutoring or reading with children as needed
- You will be provided and trained on curriculum, but will be responsible for leading various activities with your class such as art, reading activities, math activities, and science lessons
- Reporting to Children's Ministry Director

### **Managing Behavior**

- Attending and participating in behavior management trainings conducted by Children's Ministry Director
- Positively managing behavior of the students in your class through creative and affirming means
- Actively participating in the BBC wide behavior management system
- Exhibiting patience and firmness with children

### **Discipleship Community:**

- Explicit Spiritual Activities:
  - Be able to present the gospel to your class and answer gospel related questions
  - Participate in weekly chapel
  - Lead a weekly small group discussion with your students after chapel on the Bible story/spiritual principle

### **Requirements**

Must have valid driver's license. A vehicle and adequate driving record are a bonus.  
Must have an active relationship with Jesus Christ.  
Must love working with children.

### **Not required but strongly encouraged:**

Cross cultural relationship skills.  
Passion for at-risk youth or inner city communities.
